



WHO WE ARE



OBJECTIVES

Our inaugural efforts will focus on three areas:





A NATIVE GARDEN

Inspired by Mallory's book, The Gottlieb Native Garden: A California Love Story.

We will work with local agricultural extensions, Master Gardener clubs, and other environmentally minded organizations to establish a sustainable native plant ecosystem in order to make more greenspace available in underserved communities.

AWARENESS

Public Screening: Salt in My Soul Film

We will work with a local organization to provide a public screening of the Salt in My Soul documentary. This event will raise awareness for the issues Mallory writes about and stood for. Funds generated will be donated to Mallory's Legacy Fund or a local charitable organization of choice.





ACTIVISM

The Pasteur Act

Teachers will lead students on a campaign to advocate for the passage of the Pasteur Act and other legislation that promotes funding for research and treatment of antibiotic resistant bacteria.

We will focus our efforts on lobbying national leaders to support and promote such legislation.
